

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 61-77

1 WHEREAS, the law firm of STRICKLAND & ALTAFFER was by General Counsel
2 Contract HB 50C1420 retained as general counsel to represent
3 the Papago Tribe for a period of two years, effective Septem-
4 ber 25, 1975, through September 24, 1977; and

5 WHEREAS, at the time said Contract was negotiated neither the Tribe
6 nor its general counsel could accurately estimate the amount
7 of time or legal expenses which would be required to repre-
8 sent the Tribe, and consequently the Contract provides that
9 the Tribe would be billed at the rate of \$35.00 per hour for
10 legal services rendered in excess of the seventy (70) hours
11 per month covered by a \$2500.00 monthly retainer; and

12 WHEREAS, in order to set a fixed estimate for attorneys' fees and
13 expenses to be included in the Tribe's general budget, a
14 limitation was set in the Contract of \$100,000.00 per year,
15 representing an estimated 3000 hours for legal services, and
16 \$7500.00 per year for expenses; and

17 WHEREAS, during the contract year the Tribe will have received reim-
18 bursement of approximately \$31,000.00 in indirect costs under
19 Federal contracts attributable to attorneys' fees and
20 expenses; and

21 WHEREAS, over the contract year the Tribe did or will require legal
22 services of its general counsel in excess of its original
23 budgetary estimate, and it is presently estimated that the
24 Papago Tribe will require approximately three thousand five
25 hundred hours of legal services during said period; and

26 WHEREAS, over the contract year the need for and the cost of legal
27 expenses has increased and it will be necessary to increase
28 the \$7500.00 limitations for such expenses set in the Contract.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the \$100,000.00 maximum fee set
30 in the General Counsel Contract with the law firm of
31 STRICKLAND & ALTAFFER be increased to \$122,500.00, and the
32 expenses limitations be increased from \$7,500.00 to \$10,000.00

1 and that said Contract be and it is hereby amended to
2 reflect such increases.
3 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
4 the 22nd day of July, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present
5 with a vote of 993.5 for; 0 against; 71.5 not voting; and 4 absent,
6 pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (b)
7 and Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and
8 By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on
9 December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on
10 January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
11 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its
12 approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject
13 to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
