

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 73-77

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has retained the law firm of Strickland and Altaffer
2 under a General Counsel Contract dated September 25, 1975, (Contract No
3 H50C14209701), which Contract was amended by Council Resolution No.
4 61-77; and

5 WHEREAS, said General Counsel Contract expires on the 24th of September, 1977,
6 and the law firm of Strickland and Altaffer has performed its duties
7 under said contract proficiently and competently; and

8 WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Papago Tribe to retain the law firm of Strickla
9 and Altaffer as General Counsel for an additional two-year period.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the law firm of
11 Strickland and Altaffer be employed by the Papago Tribe under and pursu
12 to the terms of the attached General Counsel Contract, and any amend-
13 ments or extensions thereof, and the Chairman and Secretary of the Papa
14 Council are hereby authorized and directed to execute said Contract for
15 and on behalf of the Papago Tribe.

16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 15th
17 day of September, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
18 vote of 1065.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent,
19 pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (b) and 3 (a) and (h)
20 of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended,
21 Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
22 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of
23 its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review
24 by the Secretary of Interior.
