

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 76-77


1 WHEREAS, the Indian Oasis Public School has severe housing problems  
2 for their employees (the teachers); and  
3 WHEREAS, because of the housing shortage many of the employees  
4 traveled back and forth from Tucson to Sells to teach; and  
5 WHEREAS, there were times when the vans had mechanical problems on  
6 the road and teachers were unable to be in their class-  
7 rooms when school began that day; and  
8 WHEREAS, the Papago Education Committee has requested the Papago  
9 Council to make every effort within their powers to search  
10 every possible way to provide the housing for the teachers  
11 so that in turn they may provide better education services  
12 for the students.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council hereby  
14 supports the request of the Papago Education Committee.  
15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on  
16 the 15th day of September, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum  
17 was present with a vote of 1065.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting;  
18 and 0 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by  
19 Section 2 (a) (d) (h) & (k) of Article V of the Constitution and  
20 By-laws of the Papago Tribe, as amended, ratified by the Tribe on  
21 December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on  
22 January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934  
23 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its  
24 enactment by the Papago Council and is not subject to review by the  
25 Secretary of Interior.
