RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

(Authorizing construction contract for work at San Simon School)

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs plans to construct a 7 unit mobile home park at San Simon school; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau wishes to negotiate with Papago Construction Department for said construction; and

WHEREAS, the proposed contract price of \$28,394.00 is reasonable for the job to be done; and

WHEREAS, such a contract will benefit the Tribe by maximizing the employment of Papago workers and by contributing toward overhead expenses of the Construction Department; and

WHEREAS, a Tribal resolution authorizing such a contract is required by the Bureau.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Papago Council that it does request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the Papago Tribe Construction Department for said work; and

Be it further resolved that the Council does authorize the Chairman or, in his absence, the Vice-Chairman or Treasurer to negotiate such a contract and to sign all documents related to the contract or amendments thereto during the life of the contract.

The forgoing resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the <u>10</u> day of <u>October1977</u>, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1065.0</u> for; <u>0</u> against; <u>0</u> not voting; and <u>0</u> absent persuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section <u>3(1)</u>

of Article ____of the constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, persuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
