

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 85-77

- 1 WHEREAS, funds are available form Title V of the Older Americanas Act for the
2 purpose of Acqution, Alteration or renovation of structures for the
3 establishment of multi-purpose Senior Center and
- 4 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribel already operates programs for Senior Citizens in the
5 district of San Xavier, Schuk Toak, Sells, Baboquivari, Chukut-Kuk and
6 Sif Oidak, and,
- 7 WHEREAS, These opeations are limited by the lack of facalities to provide these
8 services and
- 9 WHEREAS, There are funds available in Title V of the Older Americans Act, through
10 the Arizona State Bureau on Aging, to pay up to 75% of the cost of
11 Acquisition, Alteration or Renovation of structures for multi-purpose
12 Senior Centers, and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Papago Council has already approved and authorized the Chairman and
14 the Papago Wise Ones Program to apply and request for funding for Titles
15 III and VII of the Older Americans Act. The reason we are requesting
16 authorization to apply for Title V funds is that the Program wants to
17 use the Santa Rosa Community Building as a multi-purpose Senior Center.
18 In order to have a Senior Center there has to be 3 services offered.
19 So far, B.I.A.-Social Services, Food Stamps and Legal Services have
20 stated they would use the building to deliver services.
- 21 WHEREAS, the Gu Achi District has given the Wise Ones Program permission to use
22 the building for 5 years and approves the concept of starting a multi-
23 purpose Senior Center in Santa Rosa.
- 24 WHEREAS, the multi-purpose Senior Center will deliver services to the Senior
25 Citizens living in the Northwestern part of the Reservation and reduce
26 the distance traveled for services. It is our intention that in the
27 futrue more programs will utilize the Senior Center to deliver services
28 to our Senior Citizens.
- 29 WHEREAS, the estimated cost will be \$13,104.00 to renovate the Santa Rosa build-
30 ing and to provide equipment for the Senior Center.
- 31 WHEREAS, the 25% will be \$3,276.00 which will come from inkind and funds raised
32 by the Wise Ones Program.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council approve and authorize the
2 the Chairman and the Papago Wise Ones Program to request for funding
3 from the Title V of the Older American Act, through the State Bureau on
4 Aging

5 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th day
6 of October 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1065.0
7 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; 0 absent, pursuant to authority vested in it by
8 Section 2 (a) (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe, ratified
9 by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior
10 on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat.
11 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior
12 and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
