

RESOLUTION OF PAPAGO COUNCIL  
(Authorizing Construction of)  
(Model Solar Energy Home )

RES. NO. 87-77

WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe's Planning Department has acquired funding under P.L. 93-638 for the construction of a solar energy home and has requested additional funding from H.I.P. for a second model solar energy home; and


WHEREAS, the Sells District Council has approved the use of two lots in the Sells District for the construction of a model solar energy home, the Resolution approving such use and the location map describing said lots being attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, it would be in the best interest of the Papago people if an economical supply of solar energy could be developed for home use.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby approve the use by the Papago Tribe's Planning Department of one of the lots described in the attached location map for the purpose of constructing a model solar energy home with P.L. 93-638 funding and that it will consider the approval of the use of the second lot when H.I.P. funding is made available for construction of another model solar energy home.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 26th day of October, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present, with a vote of 824.0 for; 0 against; 241.0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) (c) (d) and (h) of Article V and Section 4 of Article VIII of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
