

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 89-77

1 WHEREAS, Claudina and Peter Blaine, enrolled members of Chukut kuk  
2 District and residents of Sells Village, are desirous of  
3 better housing and have applied for financing through  
4 Farmers Home Administration (FHA); and

5 WHEREAS, a lot is needed to build a house on; and

6 WHEREAS, the Blaines appeared before the Chukut Kuk District Council  
7 and requested a lot described herein; and

8 WHEREAS, at their meeting of September 17, 1977, the Chukut Kuk  
9 District Council did pass a Resolution approving the  
10 the assignment of said land to the Blaines for use as a  
11 home site; and

12 WHEREAS, it is a Farmers Home Administration requirement that the  
13 Tribal Council approve the assignment of said land to Mr.  
14 & Mrs. Blaine and also that the Council authorize the  
15 Blaines to encumber the leasehold interest with a Farmers  
16 Home Administration approved mortgage.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does  
18 accept, approve, and affirm the Chukut Kuk District Council  
19 Resolution.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to said Resolution it does  
21 assign to Claudina and Peter Blaine that parcel of land  
22 laying within the Papago Reservation and described as:

23 SAN MIGUEL PARCEL

24 That parcel of land lying in the Papago Indian Reservation  
25 Pima County, Arizona described as follows:

26 Beginning at Station 1179.25.05 of Papago Route #19;

27 Thence Southwesterly around a curve to the right having  
28 a radius of 1960.79 feet and thru 07° 51' 35" of central  
29 angle a distance of 268.98 feet to a point, said point  
30 beging Sta. 0+00 of New Construction of Papago Route  
31 #19;

32 Thence S20° 10' 05" W. a distance of 373.59 to a point  
beging Stat 3+73.59 of New Construction of Papago Route  
#19

1 Thence Southeasterly around the arc of a curve to the  
2 left having a radius of 954.01 feet and thru 19°37' 35"  
3 of central angel, a distance of 326.77 feet to a point  
4 said point being Sta. 7+00.36 of New Construction of  
5 Papago Route #19

6 Thence S00° 32' 35"W a distance of 363.75 feet to a  
7 point; said point being Sta. 10+64.11 of New Construction  
8 of Papago Route #19

9 Thence N83°58' 10"W a distance of 735.73 feet to the  
10 True Point of Beginning:

11 Thence S04° 00' 57"E a distance of 439.10 feet to a point

12 Thence S89° 54' 01"W a distance of 722.57 feet to a point

13 Thence N04° 23' 45"W a distance of 681.85 feet to a point

14 Thence S72° 05' 00"E a distance of 782.00 feet to a True  
15 Point of Beginning.

16 Containing in all 9.295 Acres.

17 BE IT FURTHUR RESOLVED That said assignment shall be for use as a  
18 home site; and

19 BE IT FURHTER RESOLVED that it does authorize the Blaines to encumber  
20 the leasehold interest with a Farmers Home Administration  
21 approved mortgage; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT if the Blaines should default in payment  
23 on said morgage that the Chukut Kuk District of the Papago  
24 Tribe shall have first right to assume said mortgage and/or  
25 to assign said mortgage to an eligible Papago resident of  
26 the Chukut Kuk District.

27 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on  
28 the 4th day of November , 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was  
29 present with a vote of 1065.0 for; 0 against; 0 not  
30 voting; and 3 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the  
31 Papago Council, Article V, Section 2 (a) (c) & (m) and Article VIII,  
32 Section 3 (a) & (b) of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago

1 Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and  
2 approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1934 (48  
3 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its  
4 approval by the Papago Council and is not subject to review by the  
5 Secretary of the Interior.
