

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Papago Education Committee)


RES. NO 94-77

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has established the Papago Education Committee to
2 initiate, develop and coordinate Tribal educational programs on the
3 Papago Reservation such as Early Childhood Center, child day care
4 services, higher vocational, professional or adult educational programs,
5 and

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Papago Education
7 Committee is hereby authorized to negotiate grants, contract and sub-
8 contracts with Federal, State and local governments, and their depart-
9 ments, agencies, boards and commissions to provide funds or services
10 for educational programs on the Papago Reservation; and that the Chairman
11 and/or Vice Chairman of the Papago Council are hereby authorized to
12 excute such grants, contracts or subcontract on behalf of the Papago
13 Tribe and in its name.


14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 4th day
15 of November, 1977, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
16 1065.0 for 0 against, 0 not voting, and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority
17 vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) (d) (e) (f) (h) (k) and (l) of Article
18 V of the Constituiton and by-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by
19 the the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
20 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
21 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
22 Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.


