NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council hereby designates the Papago Children's Court as the Agency within the Tribe to discharge the solemn responsibilities placed upon the Tribe by the Act and hereby delegates to that Tribal body all necessary authority to meet the responsibilities arising under Public Law 95-608, the Indian Child Welfare Act of 1978.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman, Vice Chairman and
Secretary of the Papago Tribal Council are hereby
authorized and directed to execute, at the request of the
Judge of the Papago Children's Court, any documents
necessary to effectuate the purposes of the Resolution.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 17th day of December, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 965 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (h) and (i) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937 (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
