## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RES. NO. 101-79 1 WHEREAS, the Papago Agency has six (6) buildings that are excess to its needs and are identified as Buildings No. 4 and 5, 2 3 Quarters No. 3, 11, and 17, and 54 4 WHEREAS, various Departments of the Papago Tribal Government and 5 individual employees are in need of either office space 6 or living quarters, and WHEREAS, the Papago Agency is willing to transfer the above 8 mentioned buildings to the Papago Tribe for occupancy 9 and maintenance, and 10 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Buildings 11 No. 4 and 5, Quarters No.3,11,17 and 54 be transferred 12 to the Papago Tribe for occupancy and maintenance as it 13 is to the best interest of the Government and exercise 14 of tribal self-determination for the Papago Tribe. 15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the <u>26th</u> day of <u>December</u>, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>965</u>. for; <u>0</u> against; <u>0</u> not voting; 4 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council 17 by Article V, Section 2 (a) and (f) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984).
