

RESOLUTION OF PAPAGO COUNCIL
(FY 80 Appropriation Requests)

RES. NO. 17-79

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has reviewed its long range planning
2 programs and needs for the Papago Indian Reservation;
and

3 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has approved certain programs and
4 projects, and has set priorities therefor, in accordance
with the attached "Schedule of FY 80 Appropriation
5 Requests," for which special FY 1980 funding and appro-
priations are needed; and

6 WHEREAS, said programs and projects require the cooperation and
7 assistance of many Federal agencies and the United States
Congress; and

8 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe wishes to develop said programs and
9 projects in close cooperation with appropriate Federal
agencies.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the
11 Chairman and other appropriate officers of the Papago
12 Council be and they are hereby authorized and directed
to take any and all steps necessary to insure that the
13 said programs and projects are properly funded and that
14 the necessary coordination with appropriate Federal
15 agencies is received to implement said programs and
16 projects.

17 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council
18 on the _____ day of February, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum
19 was present with a vote of _____ for; _____ against; _____ not
20 voting; and _____ absent, pursuant to authority vested in the
21 Papago Council by Section 2 (d) of Article V of the Constitution
22 and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Papago
23 Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
24 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
25 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
26 review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the
27 date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
