WHEREAS, the Papago Juvenile Detention Officer project has been

identified as a priority in the Juvenile Justice Program; THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribe is fully supportive and endorses the continuation of the Papago Juvenile Detention Officer project as a means of developing and improving the quality of juvenile justice on the Papago Reservation.

LET IT ALSO BE RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribe, through the Administration will use the funds only for the purpose as stated.

LET IT BE FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Papago Tribe request a waiver of any required cash match and will provide any necessary documents as needed by the Arizona State Justice Planning Agency.

LET BE FINALLY BE RESOLVED, that the Chairman, or his designee, is authorized to carry out the responsibility of providing documents, negotiating terms, and signing all necessary papers from application through completion of project funds.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9th day of April , 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of \_\_\_\_1031 against; 34 not voting; and absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Sections 2(a) and (m) and 3(h) and (1) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
