

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBE
Grants & Contract Resolution

RES. NO. 28-79

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe recognizes the need for Tribal programs
2 and departments to seek funding from federal, state and
3 other funding agencies and organizations in order to try
4 to meet the needs of the Papago people; and

5 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe recognizes that there is currently no
6 tribal program or department to coordinate all tribal
7 funding requests; and

8 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe recognizes the need for planning and
9 coordinating these funding requests from the tribal
10 programs and departments; and

11 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe recognizes the need for the account-
12 ability for all grants and contracts to not only the
13 funding agencies but most importantly, to the Papago
14 people; and

15 WHEREAS, the Grants and Contracts Office was established by the
16 Papago Tribal Council in September of 1976 with the intent
17 that this office be the clearinghouse for all grant/
18 contract activities of the Tribe; and

19 WHEREAS, the Grants and Contracts Office has also been assigned
20 to assist the Tribal Accounting Office in the financial
21 management and coordination of all grants and contracts;
22 and

23 WHEREAS, the duties and responsibilities of this office and staff
24 has been reviewed and approved by the Papago Tribal
25 Council.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Tribal Council
27 authorizes the Grants and Contracts Office, in cooper-
28 ation and coordination with the Tribal Accounting Office,
29 to oversee and monitor all fundings requested and/or
30 received by the Papago Tribe as outlined in the approved
31 duties and responsibilities.

32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Grants and Contracts Office work

1 closely with all tribal programs and departments and
2 include them in the decision-making process when
3 decisions to be made affect their program or department.

4 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council
5 on the 9th day of April, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was
6 present with a vote of 948.5 for; 0 against; 116.5 not voting;
7 and 0 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by
8 Section 2(e) (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws
9 of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on
10 December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior
11 on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
12 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review
13 by the Secretary of Interior and is effective of its enactment
14 by the Papago Council.
