

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Papago Farms-Vaivo Vo Farm Board)

RESOLUTION NO. 30-79

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has developed or is in the process of developing
2 the Vaiva Vo project and the Papago Farms project; and

3 WHEREAS, these two farm projects have been operating under the direction of a
4 farm board consisting of five (5) members of the Papago Tribe; and

5 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council has never formally passed a Tribal
6 resolution authorizing the creation of farm board or the appointment
7 of its five members; and

8 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Papago Tribe that a farm board
9 consisting of five (5) members be authorized and the members be
10 appointed by this Tribal Council.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that a farm board is
12 hereby created with authority to appoint an Acting Farm Manager and
13 to hire necessary consultant for the purpose of directing all Tribal
14 farming project on the Papago Reservation including, but not limited
15 to Vaiva Vo and Papago Farms.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following five people are hereby appointed to
17 serve as members of the Farm Board for a period of 60 days from the
18 date of this Resolution:

20 Edward Kisto

21 Patrick Franko

22 William Lewis, Sr.

23 Maynard Joaquin

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Farm Board submit to the Tribal Council within
25 sixty (60) days a plan of operation and board powers for consideration and
26 further action by this Council.

28 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 9
29 day of April, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
30 vote of 1047.5 for; 0 against; 17.5 not voting; and 0 absent,
31 pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (e) of Article V
32 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the
Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior
on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior
and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
