

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBE
(Federal Land Studies in Sif Oidak District)

RES. NO. 33-79

1 WHEREAS, the Bureau of Reclamation and the U.S. Geological Survey
2 are, by application, requesting authority to conduct
3 land-subsidence and earth fissure investigations in the
4 Sif Oidak District of the Papago Reservation; and

5 WHEREAS, the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service and the Bureau of
6 Reclamation are requesting authority to conduct investi-
7 gations in the Sif Oidak District of the Papago Reserva-
8 tion for the purpose of preparing a Planning Aid Report
9 for the water delivery system of the Central Arizona
10 Project; and

11 WHEREAS, the Sif Oidak District Council has by resolution approved
12 the granting of the necessary authority and permits to
13 make such investigations and reports; and such investi-
14 gations and reports are of benefit to the Papago Tribe.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the
16 Bureau of Reclamation, the U.S. Geological Survey and the
17 U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service are hereby authorized to
18 enter upon the Papago Reservation in the Sif Oidak
19 District for the purposes of making such investigations
20 and reports.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon completion of their investigations
22 and reports they file a copy of their reports with the
23 Councils of both the Sif Oidak District and the Papago
24 Tribe.

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and other appropriate
26 officers of the Papago Council are hereby directed to
27 execute any applications, permits or documents necessary
28 to implement the purposes of this Resolution.

29 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
30 the 20th day of April 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum
31 was present, with a vote of 1101.0 for; 0 against; 54 not
32 voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the
Council by Section 2 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution
and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago
Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of

1 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
2 review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the
3 date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
