

RESOLUTION OF THE PAAPGO COUNCIL
(Appointment of Children's Court Judge)

RES. NO. 36-79

1 WHEREAS, Section 2 of Chapter I of the Law and Order Code of the
2 Papago Tribe provides that the Papago Tribal Courts shall
3 consist of two regular Judges, one of which as been acting
4 as Judge of the Children's Court, and such Judges "shall
5 be appointed by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, subject
6 to confirmation by a majority vote of the Papago Council",
7 for a term of two years; and
8 WHEREAS, there is presently no appointed and acting Judge of the
9 Children's Court; and
10 WHEREAS, the Law and Order Code requires that the Judges be members
11 of the Papago Tribe who have never been conficted of a
12 felony, or, within the year then last past, of a misdemeanor;
13 and
14 WHEREAS, Ned Norris, Jr. meets the foregoing criteria and has been
15 selected by the Papago Council as best qualified to assume
16 the position of Judge of the Children's Court.
17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does
18 hereby designate and confirm the appointment of Ned Norris, Jr.
19 as Judge of the Children's Court for a term of two years
20 from date of appointment, and requests that the Commissioner
21 of Indian Affairs appoint its designee to such position.
22 The foregoing Resolution as duly enacted by the Papago Council on
23 the 4th day of May, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was
24 present with a vote of (see attached voting sheet) pursuant to the
25 authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (b) and (f) of Article
26 V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended,
27 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by
the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Reso-
lution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Super-
intendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the
Secretary of Interior.
