

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBE
(Notices of Public Hearings)

RES. NO. 38-79

1 WHEREAS, various federal, state and other agencies, including the
2 Revenue Sharing Office, allocate funds annually to the
3 Papago Tribe of Arizona, and such agencies establish
4 guidelines for use of their funds.

5 WHEREAS, the Revenue Sharing Office and other agencies require
6 receipts of their funds to hold public hearings, with
7 public participation, to plan use of funds they allocate,
8 and to adopt budgets. Further, these agencies specify
9 that notices of public hearing be publicize within
10 definite number of days, set by the state or local gov-
11 ernment ordinance, before the public hearings are held.

12 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona, a local government, does not
13 have an ordinance or a resolution that specifies a time
14 limit (in days) within which to publicize notice of a
15 public hearing to comply with the Revenue Sharing and
16 other agencies' requirements.

17 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that notices, stating the purpose, time,
18 date(s) and places, shall be publicized as widely and as
19 quickly as possible by whatever means to inform all persons
20 concerned, at least three (3) work days before any hearing
21 requiring public participation. Upon adoption, this res-
22 olution fulfills the prior notice requirements for public
23 hearings

24 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
25 the 11th day of May, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present
26 with a vote of 1065.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting;
27 and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago
28 Council by Section 2(d)(e) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution
29 and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago
30 Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the
31 Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
32 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to
review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date
of its enactment by the Papago Council.
