

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Sells District - Water and Sewer)

RES. NO. 40-79

1 WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service is committed to assist with the
2 extension of water and sewer services to Indian people
3 living on reservations in need of such services; and

4 WHEREAS, there are six (6) families; Annie Felix, Ken McCloud, Harry
5 Miguel, Bernard Matthews Jr., Ramon Ruiz Sr., and Ramon
6 Ruiz Jr., which live on individual lots in the southeastern
7 area of Sells today and are without water and sewer services
8 even though water and sewer is available for other people
9 in the community; and

10 WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service, Office of Environmental Health,
11 has indicated that it has made a thorough field study of
12 the said area and has determined that due to the terrain
13 it is not feasible possible to develop sewage disposal
14 facilities for these six (6) homes, but that IHS would
15 cooperate in bringing water to the homes; and

16 WHEREAS, the Sells District Council is concerned about providing
17 these services to these residents.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sells District Council does
19 hereby request the assistance of the Papago Council in
20 petitioning the Indian Health Service to provide water
21 and sewage services for the six (6) homes.

22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
23 the 14th day of May, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was
24 present with a vote of 1065.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting;
25 and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by
26 Sections 1. (a) & (h) of Article V. of the Constitution and By-
27 Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe
28 on December 14, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior
29 on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
30 1934 (48 Stat. 984) of the Interior and is effective as of the
31 date of its enactment by the Papago Council
