5	of the Lease, and an expansion of the building by construction funded						
6	by the Postal Service under the terms of a Supplemental Agreement						
7	(PS Form 7401); and						
8	WHEREAS, such expansion of the Post Office Building and extension and amendment						
9	of the terms of the Lease are of benefit to the Papago Tribe.						
10	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby						
11	approve the Amendment To Lease and the Supplemental Agreement (PS Form						
12	7401) with the United States Postal Service coverning extension and						
13	amendment of the terms of the Lease dated October 10, 1963, and funding						
14	for an expansion of the Sells Post Office Building, and does hereby						
15	authorize and direct Cecil Williams, Chairman of the Papago Council,						
16	and any other appropriate officer or agent of the Council to execute						
17	such other instruments and do such other things as are necessary or						
18	incidental to achieve the purposes of this Resolution.						
19	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 14th						
20	day of May, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1015.5 for; 0 against; 49.5 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant						
21	to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a), 3 (h) of Article V and Section 4 of Article VIII of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe						
22	as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior On January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the						
23	Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject						
24	to review by the Secretary of Interior.
