

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL  
(Lease and Expansion of Sells  
Post Office Building)

RES. NO. 41-79

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 1315 the Papago Council did authorize the execution of a Lease dated October 10, 1963, with the United States Postal Service ("Postal Service") for the Sells Post Office Building; and

WHEREAS, the Postal Service has requested extension and amendment of the terms of the Lease, and an expansion of the building by construction funded by the Postal Service under the terms of a Supplemental Agreement (PS Form 7401); and

WHEREAS, such expansion of the Post Office Building and extension and amendment of the terms of the Lease are of benefit to the Papago Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby approve the Amendment To Lease and the Supplemental Agreement (PS Form 7401) with the United States Postal Service covering extension and amendment of the terms of the Lease dated October 10, 1963, and funding for an expansion of the Sells Post Office Building, and does hereby authorize and direct Cecil Williams, Chairman of the Papago Council, and any other appropriate officer or agent of the Council to execute such other instruments and do such other things as are necessary or incidental to achieve the purposes of this Resolution.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 14th day of May, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1015.5 for; 0 against; 49.5 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a), 3 (h) of Article V and Section 4 of Article VIII of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior On January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
