## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL (International Boundary Fence)

RES. NO. 42-79 WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk District has received and made numerous complaints concerning the operation and maintenance of 2 3 the International Boundary fence; and has requested the Papago Council to investigate such complaints and support 5 the District in seeking resolutions thereof; and WHEREAS, the Papago Council has made such an investigation, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council finds: 7 8 That the International Boundary fence is in need of immediate repair of replacement. 9 10 That it would substantially reduce the intentional cutting of the fence and the resulting straying of 11 Papago and Mexican livestock across the border if the existing gates were left unlocked. 12 13 That individual fences on the Mexican side of the border connecting to the International Boundary fence 14 are placed there illegally and should be removed. 15  $\parallel$  BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman and other appropriate 16 officers, agents and attorneys of the Papago Council are 17 hereby authorized and directed to work with the Bureau 18 of Indian Affairs and such other departments or agencies 19 of the Federal or Mexican governments reponsible for, 20 or having jurisdiction over the International Boundary fence 21 in order to accomplish the purposes of this Resolution. 22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 14th. day of May, 1979, at a meeting at which a quroum was present with a vote of 962 for; 0 against; 103 no voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
