

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL  
(Authorizing Issuance of Enrollment  
Applications to Sonoran Papagos)

RES. NO. 45-79

1 WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk District Council did by formal Resolution  
2 request that the Papagos living within the State of Sonora,  
3 Mexico, be recognized as members of the Papago Tribe and  
4 be entitled to share in the Tribe's land judgement funds;  
5 and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has the power, under Section 2 of Arti-  
7 cal II of the Papago Constituion, "to adopt into tribal  
8 membership anyone who is one-half degree or more of  
9 Papago Indian blood"; and

10 WHEREAS, the exact number, wishes and degree of Indian blood of  
11 Papagos living in the state of Sonora are presently un-  
12 known to the Enrollment Committee or to the Papago; and

13 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has by Ordinance No. 49 established  
14 formal procedures for enrollment in the Papago Tribe.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does  
16 hereby authorize and direct the Papago Enrollment Com-  
17 mittee to make available and distribute enrollment ap-  
18 plications to Papagos residing in the State of Sonora,  
19 Mexico, and accept, file and process such applications  
20 in accordance with the provisions of the Papago Tribe  
21 Enrollment Ordinance.

22 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on  
23 the 16th. day of May, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was  
24 present with a vote of 539.5 for; 310.5 against; 215 not  
25 voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in  
26 the Council by Section 2 of Article II and Sections 2 (c), (f) and  
27 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago  
28 Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936  
and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,  
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).  
Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of In-  
terior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the  
Papago Council.
