RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL (Authorizing cost of living and merit pay increases).

RES. No.46-79

WHEREAS. the Papago Council has under consideration the FY 1979 2 Tribal budget; and 3 WHEREAS, it appears therefrom that there are sufficient funds immediately available to the Tribe to provide for 5 reasonable cost of living and merit pay increases; and 6 WHEREAS. the Papago Council has determined that an across the 7 board ten percent (10%) cost of living increase should 8 be granted to all employees of the Tribe, and that a one 9 to five percent (1 to 5%) merit increase should be 10 granted to deserving employees of the Tribe, effective 11 October 1, 1978. 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does 13 hereby authorize and direct, retroactive as of October 14 1, 1978, and effective immediately, that all employees 15 of the Tribe be granted a ten percent (10%) cost of 16 living increase, and that deserving employees of the Tribe 17 be granted a one to five percent (1 to 5%) merit increase. 18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the <u>llth</u>. day of <u>May</u>, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>l065</u> for; <u>0</u> against; <u>0</u> not voting and <u>2</u> absent, pursuant to the <u>authority</u> vested in the Council 19 by Section 2 (a) and Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified 21 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
