

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(May 26, 1979, General Election)

RES. NO. 47-79

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe did on Saturday, May 26, 1979, have a
2 General Election for the offices of Chairman and Vice-
3 Chairman and Representatives and Alternates to the Papago
4 Council, and for the offices of Representatives and
5 Alternates to the District Councils; and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Election Board did issue and post its Certifi-
7 cates of Election Results in accordance with Section 4 (J)
8 of Article VI of the Uniform Election Ordinance, certifying
9 to the election of the candidates who received the highest
10 number of votes for elective office; and

11 WHEREAS, under Section 4 (M) of Article VI of the Uniform Election
12 Ordinance, it is incumbent upon the Papago Council to
13 issue Certificates of Election to the candidates who
14 received the highest number of votes for each office or
15 Council seat within 10 days after the Election Board has
16 posted its Certificates of Election Results unless an
17 election contest statement is filed within the time allowed
18 and provided.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL that the
20 Chairman and Secretary of the Papago Council are hereby
21 authorized and directed on behalf of the Papago Council
22 to execute and deliver a Certificate of Election to the
23 following persons selected either at large as Chairman
24 and Vice-Chairman of the Papago Council, or from their
25 respective Districts as Representatives and Alternates
26 to the Papago Council, who shall hold offices for a term
27 of four (4) years and until their successors are certified
28 and seated, to-wit:

24 the 4th. day of June, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was
25 present with a vote of 858 for; 99 against; 108 not
26 voting; and 4 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in
27 the Council by Section 2 (a), (c) and (f) of Article V of the
28 Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified
29 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the
30 Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16
31 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is
32 not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective
as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
