

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RESOLUTION 4-79

- 1 WHEREAS, The Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe authorizes and
2 empowers the Tribal Council to engage in activities for the Welfare
3 and Benefit of the Tribe and Tribal Members, and
- 4 WHEREAS, Under subsection 271.18 of P.L. 93-638, the Tribal Council must
5 request the Bureau to enter into contract with a Tribal organization,
6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, The Tribal Council authorized the Papago Education Committee as a Tribal
8 Organization to serve the Educational Needs of the Papago Tribal
9 Members on the Papago Reservation, and
- 10 WHEREAS, The Papago Tribal Council further authorizes the Education Committee
11 to submit applications for contract programs, and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Papago Education Committee sees the need for Training Facilities
13 on the Reservation due to:
- 14 A. Ennumerable skill jobs are lost annually because of the lack of
15 Vocational Training for employment skills.
 - 16 1) The lack of Training Facilities in High School, students are
17 deprived of vocational education.
 - 18 2) Problems arise with Off Reservation Training in room and board,
19 day care and transportation, causing poor success rate and drop-
20 out.
 - 21 B. There are no training facilities on the Papago Reservation.
 - 22 1) \$900,000.00 is spent for vocational education training off
23 Reservation annually.
 - 24 2) The nearest Vocational Training facility is located in Tucson,
25 Arizona, sixty miles away.
 - 26 C. There is a demonstrated need for Vocational Education Training
27 Center to be located on the Papago Reservation.
 - 28 1) Approximately ten million (10,000,000) of new construction funds
29 has been approved on the Papago Reservation in the next several
30 years.
 - 31 2) The development of Copper Mines are now in existence.
 - 32 3) Agriculture development is in process.
 - 33 4) The Papago Employment Rights: Ordinance No. 1.78 insures that
34 Tribal Members are given preference in all employment on the
35 Reservation.

1 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, The Papago Tribal Council hereby authorizes
2 the Papago Education Committee to negotiate and enter a contract
3 with the Bureau of Indian Affairs and Health, Education and Welfare
4 CFDA #13.588 for a Vocational Education Training Facilities Center
5 and operational funding.

6 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10TH
7 day of January, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with
8 a vote of 737.5 for, 185 against, 142.5 not voting, and 2 absent
9 pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2. (a) (k) of Article
10 V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe, as amended and
11 ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of
12 the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,
13 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the
14 Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment
15 by the Papago Council.
