


Resolution of the Papago Tribal Council  
(Appropriation of \$273,640.00 to the  
Mi-Casa Builders, Inc. for the Papago  
Multi-Health Complex)

RES. NO. 50 - 79

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe did on June 6, 1978 enter into contract  
2 for the construction of the Papago Multi-Health Complex  
3 in Sells with Mi-Casa Builders, Inc.; and  
4 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe did receive a grant from the Economic  
5 Development Administration (LPW Project #07-51-20308)  
6 for the construction of said Complex; and  
7 WHEREAS, the grant is insufficient to complete the Complex in  
8 accordance with the terms of the contract with Mi-Casa  
9 Builders, Inc.; and  
10 WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the Papago Tribe that the complex  
11 be completed; and  
12 WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds on deposit to the credit of the  
13 Papago Tribe to fund the amounts needed to complete the  
14 Complex.  
15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Papago Council that it does  
16 hereby appropriate the amount of \$273,640.00 for the  
17 construction of the Papago Multi-Health Complex, and does  
18 thereby authorize the Treasurer and other appropriate  
19 officers of the Papago Tribe to expend such sum upon  
20 presentation of proper vouchers or receipts by Mi-Casa  
21 Builders, Inc. their subcontractors, agents, successors  
22 or assigns.

23 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council  
24 on the 20 day of June, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum  
25 was present with a vote of 779.5 for; 0 against; 185.5  
26 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to authority vested in  
27 the Council by 2 (a) Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the  
28 Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified  
29 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the  
30 Secretary of Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16  
31 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
32 effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent  
of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary  
of Interior.
