

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBE
(Authorizing per diem increases)
(for meetings of the Papago)
(Council)

RES. NO. 51-79

1 WHEREAS, members of the Papago Council have not received any
2 increases of their fees for attending Council meetings
3 for a long period of time; and
4 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has refrained from making such increases
5 until the Tribe had sufficient funds on hand; and
6 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed the Tribal budget and
7 assets and finds that funds are available for such in-
8 creases, and that such increases are justified.
9 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Papago Council that
10 the per diem fees paid to members of the Papago Council
11 be increased by fifteen per cent (15%) from \$90.00 per
12 day to \$103.50 per day, retroactively effective October
13 1, 1978.

14 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
15 the 27th. day of June, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was
16 present with a vote of 446 for; 111 against; 379 not
17 voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in
18 the Council by Section 2 (a) and Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article
19 V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended,
20 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved
21 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to
22 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Res-
23 olution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Super-
24 intendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the
25 Secretary of Interior.
