

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Adoption of FY 1979 Annual Budget)

RES. NO. 52-79

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has deferred adoption of a final FY 1979
2 annual budget until completion of negotiations of a new
3 mining agreement for the Lakeshore Mine, and did adopt
4 three interim budget covering the first three quarters
5 of FY 1979; and

6 WHEREAS, such negotiations are now complete and a mining agreement
7 was entered into with the Noranda Exploration Company; and

8 WHEREAS, the Council's Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed
9 the budget requests of the various programs and depart-
10 ments of the Papago Tribe and has made its recommendations
11 to the Papago Council; and

12 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does
13 hereby adopt the attached budget as the tribes final
14 FY 1979 annual budget.

19 The forgoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council
20 on the 29th. day of June, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum
21 was present with a vote of 965.0 for; 0 against; 0
22 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to authority vested in
23 the Council by Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Consti-
24 tution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by
25 the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary
26 of Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
27 of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as
28 of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
29 Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
