WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona has been invited by the Department of Housing and Urban Development to submit a 2 full application in the amount of \$100,000 to fund housing 3 rehabilitation for the elderly, handicapped and low income 4 on the Papago Reservation, and: 5 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has satisfied the requirement for citizen 6 participation as stated in Resolution 11-79, which was 7 submitted with the preapplication. 8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: 9 1. The Papago Tribe will implement the Community Develop-10 ment Block Grant Program to benefit the elderly, handicapped and low income as described in the attached work 11 program and budget. 12 2. The Papago Tribe will operate the Community Development Block Grant Program in compliance with FMC 74-4 and OMB 13 Circular A-102, Title II of Pulbic Law 90-284 (25 USC 1301) (the Indian Civil Rights Act) S57.507 of Title II. 14 3. The Papago Tribe will grant to Department of Housing 15 and Urban Development and the Comptroller General access to and right to examine all books, records, papers or documents related to the grant for a period 16 of no less than three years after project completion. 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Chairman, or in his absence, the 18 Vice-Chairman or the Treasurer are hereby authorized to 19 20 negotiate and sign whatever grant documents are required and, further, to negotiate and sign amendments and exten-21 22 sions to such grant. The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on 2ND. day of July , 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present 24 with a vote of 458 for; 111 against; 396 not voting; and 1 absent
pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (d) of
Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). 27 Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the 28 Papago Council.
