1	WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona is presently operating the
2	following programs under FY 79 P.L. 93-638 service
3	contracts with the Bureau of Indian Affairs:

9	WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial
10	to the Papago Tribe and its people, and
11	WHEREAS, 25 CFR Sec. 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires
12	that all proposals to recontract under P.L. 93-638 be
13	submitted to the Tribal Council for approval at least 120
14	days prior to the contract termination; and
15	WHEREAS, the Papago Council does desire to recontract for provision
16	of these services during FY-80.
17	OW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does
18	authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to
19	contract with the Papago Tribe under P.L. 93-638 regulations
20	and procedures for the provision of services titled:

	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Max H. Norris, Chairman or in his
29	absence, Mr. Enos J. Francisco, Jr., Vice-Chairman, or Mr.

31	negotiate and execute these contracts and any amendments
32	thereto for the duration of the contracts.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of these contracts shall 2 be from October 1, 1979 to September 30, 1980, but may be 3 extended by mutual agreement of both parties.  $^4\parallel$ The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the <u>3RD</u>. day of <u>July</u>, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>965.0</u> for; <u>0</u> against; <u>0</u> not voting; and <u>0</u> absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe on December 12,  $7 \parallel 1936$  and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
