

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RESOLUTION NO. 54-79

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona is presently operating the
2 following programs under FY 79 P.L. 93-638 service
3 contracts with the Bureau of Indian Affairs:

4 Papago Children's Home
5 Papago Agricultural Services
6 Papago Court
7 Papago Enrollment
8 Papago JOM Education
9 Papago Halfway House
10 Papago Tribal Work Experience Program (TWEP)
11 Papago Education Office (Community Education); and

12 WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial
13 to the Papago Tribe and its people, and

14 WHEREAS, 25 CFR Sec. 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires
15 that all proposals to recontract under P.L. 93-638 be
16 submitted to the Tribal Council for approval at least 120
17 days prior to the contract termination; and

18 WHEREAS, the Papago Council does desire to recontract for provision
19 of these services during FY-80.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does
21 authorize and request the Bureau of Indian Affairs to
22 contract with the Papago Tribe under P.L. 93-638 regulations
23 and procedures for the provision of services titled:

24 Papago Children's Home
25 Papago Agricultural Services
26 Papago Court
27 Papago Enrollment
28 Papago JOM Education
29 Papago Halfway House
30 Papago Tribal Work Experience Program (TWEP)
31 Papago Education Office (Community Education)

32 and in accordance with the attached work programs, staffing
and budget requests.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Max H. Norris, Chairman or in his
absence, Mr. Enos J. Francisco, Jr., Vice-Chairman, or Mr.
Vincent L. Crawford, Treasurer is hereby authorized to
negotiate and execute these contracts and any amendments
thereto for the duration of the contracts.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of these contracts shall
2 be from October 1, 1979 to September 30, 1980, but may be
3 extended by mutual agreement of both parties.

4 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
5 the 3RD. day of July, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was
6 present with a vote of 965.0 for; 0 against; 0 not voting;
7 and 0 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council
8 by Section 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of
9 the Papago Tribe of Arizona, ratified by the Tribe on December 12,
10 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6,
11 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.
12 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of
13 Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the
14 Papago Council.
