

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

RESOLUTION NO. 68-79

1 WHEREAS, the President of the United States has proclaimed Indian Self-
2 Determination as a goal of the government and has made money available
3 through the Indian Health Service to make grants to Tribal governments
4 for achieving self-determination in the health areas; and

5 WHEREAS, such grant funds are now available to the Papago Tribe for use in
6 health planning, evaluation, training, federal matching and to improve
7 and develop the Tribal Health management capability; and

8 WHEREAS, the first phase of the Multi-Health and Social Complex is near
9 completion; and

10 WHEREAS, the second phase of the Multi-Health and Social Complex will begin by
11 the acquisition of 638 funds to begin A & E Working Documents for the
12 Papago Elderly Nursing Home to be followed by the development of the
13 Children's Home, the Special Learning Center and the Papago Halfway
14 House as funding allows;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does authorize
16 and request a grant from the Indian Health Service of the Department
17 of Health, Education, and Welfare, in the amount of \$187,651.00

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it does authorize the use of said grant funds in
19 the following general areas:

- 20 1. A/E Working Documents for the Papago Nursing Home as first
21 priority.


22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that budgets for grant activities shall be determined
23 by the Chairman and Treasurer in consultation with the Executive
24 Health Staff and other staff and within the total amount of money
25 available from Indian Health Service.


26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Max Norris, Chairman; or in his absence,
27 Mr. Enos Francisco, Vice-Chairman; or Mr. Vincent Crawford, Treasurer
28 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the necessary grant
29 documents and any supplements, amendments or revisions thereto and
30 to administer such grant for the duration of the grant.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 30 day of July, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 965 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (d) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
