

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Appointing Farm Manager)

RES. NO. 69 -79

WHEREAS, the Papago Council has been considering adoption of a Plan of Operation for the Papago Farming Authority to assume responsibility for the development of agricultural resources of the Papago Tribe, including Papago Farms; and

WHEREAS, it is essential that a Farm Manager be appointed forthwith to take over management of tribal agriculture programs pending the adoption of a Plan of Operation and the appointment of a Management Board for the Papago Farming Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Farm Board previously appointed by the Papago Council did interview applicants for the position of Farm Manager and has recommended that James P. Altfillisch be appointed as such.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does in this instance waive the hiring and employment requirements of the Papago Tribe's Personnel Policies, and does hereby authorize and direct the Chairman of the Papago Council to execute a management contract with James P. Altfillisch employing him as Farm Manager having general administrative responsibility over the Tribe's agricultural programs in accordance with terms negotiated by the Farm Board and in anticipation of the adoption by the Papago Council of a Plan of Operation establishing a Papago Farming Authority and of the appointment of a Management Board.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th day of August, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 769.5 for; 0 against; 195.5 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (e), (f) and 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
