10	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Papago Construc-
11	tion Company is hereby authorized to lease, with an option to
12	purchase, one (1) 14 yard dump truck and two (2) 8 yard ready-mix
13	(cement) trucks and that \$16,900.00 is hereby authorized to be used
14	from Tribal funds for this purpose.
15	The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 27th
16	day of August, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 914 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 2 absent,
17	pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 3 (a), (h) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe as amended,
18	ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
19	Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its
20	approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency.
