

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL  
(Authorizing Cost of Living and)  
(1 to 5% Merit Pay Increases )

RES. NO. 76-79

1 WHEREAS, on the 11th day of May, 1979, the Papago Tribal Council  
2 passed Resolution No. 43-79 which had a provision for a  
3 one to five percent (1 to 5%) merit increase for deserving  
4 employees fo the Papago Tribe; and

5 WHEREAS, the wording of said resolution has created some confusion  
6 as to the intent of the Tribal Council and the meaning of  
7 the resolution; and

8 WHEREAS, it is desirable that the Tribal Council make null and  
9 void the action taken by the Council in regards to merit  
10 increases to deserving Tribal employees and direct that  
11 all merit increases to be granted shall be in accordance  
12 with the Papago Tribe's Personnel and Procedure manuel.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribe that only that  
14 portion of Resolution No. 43-79 referring to merit raises  
15 for Papago employees is hereby made null and void.

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all future merit raises to employees  
17 of the Papago Tribe shall be made in accordance with the  
18 provisions of the Papago Tribe's Personnel and Procedure  
19 manual, provided that sufficient funds are available for  
20 such purposes.

21 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council  
22 on the 7th. day of September, 1979, at a meeting at which  
23 a quorum was present with a vote of 790.5 for; 111 against; 63.5  
24 not voting; and 1 absent; pursuant to the authority vested in  
25 the Council by Section 2 (a) and Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article  
26 V of the Constituion and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended,  
27 ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved  
28 by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to  
29 Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said  
30 Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the  
31 Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by  
32 the Secretary of Interior.
