RES. NO. 76-79

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of May, 1979, the Papago Tribal Council passed Resolution No. 43-79 which had a provision for a one to five percent (1 to 5%) merit increase for deserving employees fo the Papago Tribe; and

WHEREAS, the wording of said resolution has created some confusion as to the intent of the Tribal Council and the meaning of the resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the Tribal Council make null and void the action taken by the Council in regards to merit increases to deserving Tribal employees and direct that all merit increases to be granted shall be in accordance with the Papago Tribe's Personnel and Procedure manuel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribe that only that portion of Resolution No. 43-79 referring to merit raises for Papago employees is hereby made null and void.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all future merit raises to employees of the Papago Tribe shall be made in accordance with the provisions of the Papago Tribe's Personnel and Procedure manual, provided that sufficient funds are available for such purposes.

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th. day of September ,1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 790.5 for; 111 against; 63.5 not voting; and 1 absent; pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and Section 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constituion and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
