7		Tribal Herd of the first yearling calf offspring of such						
8		loaned cows; and						
9	WHEREAS,	Resolution No. 16-73 placed upon the District Councils						
10		the responsibility to see that such yearlings be returned						
11		to the Tribal Herd; and						
12	WHEREAS,	very few of such yearlings were in fact returned to the						
13		Tribal Herd and the Papago Tribe is entitled to the return						
14	 	of either the loaned animals or of their offspring.						
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does							
16		hereby authorize and direct the Tribal Herd Manager to						
17		take possession from the persons who received loans of						
18		Black Angus cows of such cows or one of their offspring,						
19	and that he is authorized to add them to the Tribal Herd							
20	and/or dispose of same by sale as good husbandry and							
21	economic conditions suggest.
