RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

Resolution No. 78-79

WHEREAS, The Papago Council did on November 4, 1974, by Resolution 1 No. 56-74, establish the Papago Enrollment Committee, and 2 did provide that its members be paid a per diem payment of 3 4 \$25.00 for each day, or portion thereof, they attend Committee meetings, plus 12¢ per mile travelled to 5 Committee meetings or while on Committee business; and 6 7 WHEREAS, such payments reflected the prevailing rates paid by the 8 Papago Tribe to members of standing committees of the 9 Tribe in November, 1974, but do not reflect the prevail-10 ing rates paid by the Tribe today; and 11 WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Resolution No. 56-74 to afford 12 the Enrollment Committee the same rate of compensation as 13 is provided for other standing committees. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Resolution 15 No. 56-74 is hereby amended to provide that the members of the Papago Enrollment Committee shall be entitled to receive, upon presentation 16 of proper vouchers, such per diem and mileage payments for attending meetings of the Committee or while on Committee business as the 19 Papago Council may from time to time set for standing committees of 20 the Papago Tribe. 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following persons shall be members 22 of the Papago Enrollment Committee: Elena Frank 23 Henry Ramon Nancy Garcia 24 Mary Lou Williams Lyman Flores 25 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on

The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th day of September, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 927 for; 0 against; 38 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
