

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RESOLUTION NO. 81-79

1 WHEREAS, Sylvester and Mary Romero, enrolled members of SCHUK TOAK  
2 District and residents of Crowhang Community and Miss  
3 Regina Saraficio, enrolled member of GU ACHI District and  
4 resident of Covered Wells Community, and Mr. & Mrs.  
5 Thodore Antone, enrolled members of BABOQUIVARI District  
6 and residents of Topawa Community; and

7 WHEREAS, these families are desirous of better housing and have  
8 applied for financing through Farmers Home Administration  
9 (FHA); and

10 WHEREAS, they have appeared before their District Council for  
11 approval, attached to the District Resolution, is approved  
12 requested lot described herein; and

13 WHEREAS, it is a Farmers Home Administration requirement that the  
14 Tribal Council approve the assignment of said lands to the  
15 above mentioned families and also that the Council  
16 authorize Mr. & Mrs. Romero; Miss Saraficio, and Mr. &  
17 Mrs. Antone to encumber the leasehold interest with a  
18 Farmers Home Administration approved mortgage.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does  
20 accept, approve, and affirm the Resolutions of the three  
21 Districts.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT if any of the three families  
23 should default in payment on said morgage that the three  
24 Districts of the Papago Tribe shall have first right to  
25 assume said mortgage and/or to assign said mortgage to an  
26 eligible Papago resident of BABOQUIVARI, GU ACHI, SCHUK  
27 TOAK Districts.

28 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on  
29 the 7th day of September, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum  
30 was present with a vote of 965 for; 0 against; 0 not voting  
31 and 1 absent; pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council  
32 Article V, Section 2 (a) (c) & (m) and Article VIII, Section 3 (a)  
& (b) of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona  
ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the  
Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said  
Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Papago  
Council and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
