NO. 82-79 1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe has retained the law firm of Strickland & 2 Altaffer under a General Counsel Contract dated September 3 15, 1977 (Contract No. H50C14200602); and WHEREAS, said General Counsel Contract expires on the 24th day of 5 September, 1979, and the law firm of Strickland & Altaffer 6 has performed its duties under said contract proficiently 7 and competently; and WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Papago Tribe to retain the law 8 firm of Strickland & Altaffer as general counsel for an 9 additional two-year period. 10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the law 11 firm of Strickland & Altaffer be employed by the Papago 12 Tribe under and pursuant to the terms of the attached Gen-13 eral Counsel Contract, and any amendments or extensions 14 thereof, and the Chairman and Secretary of the Papago Council are hereby authorized and directed to execute said 15 Contract for and on behalf of the Papago Tribe. 16 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on 17 the 17th day of September 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 864 for; 0 against; 101 not voting; and 2 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (b) and 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Con-18 stitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by 19 the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
