8		(Act of October 27, 1978), funds would become available to the				
9		Department to meet its contract obligations with the Papago				
10		Tribe; and				
11	WHEREAS,	the Papago Tribe is by contract obligated to continue the Papago				
12		CETA Programs, and will have to borrow funds in order to continue				
13		these programs into FY 1980,				
14	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby					
15		authorize and approve the securing of a loan up to the amount				
16		of \$200,000.00 from the Valley National Bank of Arizona, Down-				
17		town Office, Tucson, Arizona, to fund the Papago-CETA Programs; and				
18	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Max H. Norris, the Chairman, or Enos J.					
19		Francisco, Jr., Vice Chairman, and Mary Jane Narcho, Secretary of				
20		the Papago Tribal Council, are hereby authorized to sign and				
21		execute a promissory note, or notes, and such other documents as				
22		may be necessary to obtain such loan.

Said Resolution is not subject to review by the Secretary of Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
