

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL  
(Chukut Kuk District Budget)

RESO. NO. 88-79

1 WHEREAS, the Chukut Kuk District Council, by resolution dated October 13, 1979,  
2 considered and approved a District budget for the period commencing  
3 October 1, 1979 and ending September 30, 1980, a copy of said resolu-  
4 tion is attached hereto and made a part hereof, and

5 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed said budget and the Districts income  
6 for this twelve month period and

7 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has determined that Chukut Kuk District has suffi-  
8 cient funds to cover its budget and that the approval of said budget  
9 would be in the best interest of the people living in said District.

10 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Papago Council does hereby approve the  
11 Chukut Kuk District budget as set forth in the October 13, 1979  
12 District Resolution attached hereto and made a part hereof.

13 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th  
14 day of November, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
15 of 965 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; and 1 absent, pursuant to  
16 authority vested in the Papago Council by Article V, Section 3 (a) (h) of the  
17 Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe  
18 on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January  
19 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).  
20 Said Resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superinten-  
21 dent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to review by the Secretary of the  
22 Interior.
