Norris, Chairman; or in his absence, 1.3 Mr. Enos J. Francisco, Jr., Vice Chairman; or the Treasurer is hereby 14 authorized to negotiate and execute this contract and any amendments 15 there for the duration of the contract 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this contract shall expire twelve 17 (12) months after it is initiated, unless extended by mutual agree-18 ment of both parties. 19 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 8th day of November, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 20 of 927 for; 38 against; of 927 for; 38 against; 0 not voting; 1 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Article V, Section 2 (a) (h) of the Constitution 21 and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12. 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant 22 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
