

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL

(Papago Construction Company First  
Right of Refusal)

Resolution No. 90-79

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Reservation has a high rate of unemployment  
2 and few job opportunities for the Papago people resid-  
3 ing on the Reservation; and

4 WHEREAS, Papago Construction Company is a Tribal organization  
5 created by the Tribal Council for the purpose of employ-  
6 ing and training Papago people in the construction trade  
7 ; and

8 WHEREAS, most federal agencies that provide funds for construct-  
9 ion on Papago lands have regulations that provide for  
10 Indian preference when contracting these projects; and

11 WHEREAS, to create training, employment and job opportunities for  
12 the Papago people, it is in the best interest of the  
13 Papago Tribe that the Papago Construction Company be  
14 guaranteed the first right of refusal of any contract  
15 and/or sub-contract to be granted for all construction  
16 projects to be built within the boundaries of the Papago  
17 Reservation.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the  
19 Papago Construction Company shall have the first right  
20 of refusal of all contracts and/or sub-contracts to be  
21 awarded or granted for all construction projects to be  
22 built within the boundaries of the Papago Reservation.

23 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on  
24 8th. day of November, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was  
25 present with a vote of 773.5 for; 38 against; 153.5 not vot-  
26 ing; and 1 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Cou  
27 Council by Section 2 (d), (h) and (m) of Article V of the  
28 Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified  
29 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the  
30 Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section  
31 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is  
32 not subject to review of the Secretary of the Interior and is  
effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
