

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL  
(Baboquivari District Budget)

Resolution No. 93-79

1 WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District Council, by Resolution dated  
2 November 26, 1979, considered and approved a District  
3 Budget for the period commencing October 1, 1979 and  
4 ending September 30, 1980, a copy of said Resolution is  
5 attached hereto and made apart hereof, and

6 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has reviewed said Budget and the  
7 Districts income for this twelve (12) month period, and

8 WHEREAS, the Papago Council has determined that Baboquivari  
9 District has sufficient funds to cover its Budget and  
10 that the approval of said Budget would be in the best  
11 interest of the people living in said District.

12 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT resolved that the Papago Council does hereby  
13 approve Baboquivari District Budget as set forth in the  
14 November 26, 1979 District Resolution attached hereto and  
15 made a part hereof.

16 The foregoing Resolutinn was duly enacted by the Papago Council on  
17 29th. day of November, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was  
18 present with a vote of 965 for; 0 against; 0 not voting;  
19 and 0 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council  
20 Council by Article V. Section 3 (a)(h) of the Constitution and By-  
21 Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on  
22 December, 1936 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on  
23 January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,  
24 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective as of the date  
25 of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is  
26 subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
