

RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL
(Amending FY 1980 Tribal Budget)

RES. NO. 94-79

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Council did on September 25, 1979, adopt the
2 FY 1980 Budget of the Papago Tribe; and

3 WHEREAS, the Phoenix Area Office of the Bureau of Indian Affairs has
4 advised the Papago Council that certain audit exceptions
5 exist under the Highway Safety Program, Contract No.
6 H50C14209249, Law Enforcement Services, Contract No.
7 H50C14209945, and Judicial Services, Contract No.
8 H50C14209946, requiring reimbursements of funds received
9 by the Papago Tribe in an amount in excess of \$18,000.00;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the Papago Tribe that such re-
12 imbursements be made under protest in equal monthly in-
13 stallments.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does
15 hereby authorize the expenditure of \$18,000.00 under
16 protest during FY 1980, payable in monthly installments
17 of \$1,500.00 in reimbursement of the aforementioned audit
18 exceptions, and that the FY 1980 Budget of the Papago
19 Tribe be amended accordingly.

20 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on
21 the 7th. day of December, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum
22 was present with a vote of 613.5 for; 93.5 against; 258 not
23 voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in
24 the Council by Section 3(a) of Article V of the Constitution and
25 By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified by the Papago
26 Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of
27 the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the
28 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is effective
29 as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago
30 Agency and is subject to review by the Secretary of Interior.
