Cholla Cattle Company, upon his 14 foregoing assurances. 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman or Vice Chairman of the 16 Papago Council is hereby authorized and directed to 17 execute and issue such permit on behalf of the Papago 18 Tribe pursuant to Ordinances No. 35 and 36. The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 10th day of December, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 688 for; 38 against; 210 not voting; and 3 absent; pursuant to the authority vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) and 3 (c) (e) of Article V of the 19 20 21 Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe as amended, ratified 22 by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 23 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
