## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL (HUD-CDBG PROGRAM PREAPPLICATION)

RESOLUTION NO. 99-79

1 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe of Arizona has been invited by the Department of 2 Housing and Urban Development to submit a preapplication for a grant 3 to fund certain eligible Community Development Block Grant Program 4 activities and in connection with such preapplication resolve and 5 make certain assurances; 6 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribe, through the Papago HUD-Community Development 7 Block Grant Program has conducted two public hearings for the 8 purpose of hearing the needs of the Papago people under HUD-CDBG 9 Program; and, 10 WHEREAS, the Papago Tribal Council on December 12, 1979, prioritized the 11 district and community requests in the following manner: 12 1. Housing Rehab Bathrooms (Inside) 13 Community Buildings 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Housing and Urban Development 15 Department, San Francisco Regional Office accept and consider this 16 Community Development Block Grant pre-application from the Papago 17 Tribe. 18 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 12th day of December, 1979, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 19 of 936 for; 0 against; 0 not voting; 3 absent, pursuant to authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (a) and (d) of Article V of 20 the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, (48 Stat. 984) pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 19, 21 1934.
