RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO TRIBAL COUNCIL (Appointing Associate Judge of) (the Papago Tribal Courts)

WHEREAS, a position as Associate Judge of the Papago Tribal Courts is presently 1 2 vacant; and WHEREAS, Section 2 of Chapter 1 of the Law and Order Code of the Papago Tribe 3 provides that Judges "shall be appointed by the Commissioner of 4 Indian Affairs, subject to confirmation by a majority vote of the 5 Papago Council;" and 6 7 WHEREAS, the Law and Order Committee has recommended the appointment of 8 Mabel P. Antone for the position of Associate Judge of the Papago Tribal Courts; and 9 WHEREAS, Mabel P. Antone meets all of the qualifications for such position. 10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that it does hereby 11 designate and confirm the appointment of Mabel P. Antone as 12 Associate Judge of the Papago Tribal Courts for a term of two 13 years from date of appointment, and requests that the Commissioner 14 of Indian Affairs appoint its designee to such position. 15 The foregoing Resolution was duly enacted by the Papago Council on the 7th 16 day of January, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 0 for; against; 0 not voting; and 17 pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) and Section 3 (b) of Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 5, 1937, 19 pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
