12	day of August, 1981, at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 609.0 for; 460.0 against; 79.0 not voting; and 0 absent, pursuant to the authority vested in the Papago Council by Section 2 (e) and (f) of							
13	Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe of Arizona as							
14	amended, ratified by the Papago Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). Said Resolution is not subject to							
15	review by the Secretary of the Interior and is effective as of the date of its enactment by the Papago Council.
